



A BRIEF HISTORY of R.B.T.S. Govt. Hom Medical College & Hospital, Muzaffarpur, Bihar-842002.

Being a student, since 1970, a member of the teaching faculties since 1977 and principal since 31st May 1993 of this college I dare to write down a brief history of the college what ever I have learnt from my teachers.

Rai Bahadur Tunki Sah (RBTS) Govt. Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Muzaffarpur (Bihar) was established in the year 1958 on 26th May. The foundation stone was laid down by the 1st President of India late Dr. Rajendra Prasad. Late Baidya Nath Prasad s/o Late Rai Bhadur Tunki Sah had Shown the generously and courage to build a Homoeopathic Medical College when Homoeopathy was very much in its embryonic state in India.

He donoted about 5 and half acres of land in the heart land of the city His Continious Positive efforts made the institution a nucleus College in the whole of Bihar, ultimately, its appreciable, infra structure attracted the Govt. of Bihar to take over of the College & Hospital.

Sri Nand Kumar Prasad Sah the then secretary of the college handed over the college to the govt. of Bihar on 01-04-1981 in full fledged running condition The examplarity sacrifice of this towering personality for the Cause of Homoeopathic education & treatment of the ailing mankind is a rarest of the rare type in this materialistic & self Centered world. He always deserves a salute from the Homoeopathic fraternity.

Today Dr. Shyam Sundar Singh the Director, ISM Bihar is leaving no stone unturned to make the institutions up to the mark.

He is working hard for starting of M.D (Hom)Course in the college soon.

About Dr. Hahnemann

Samuel Christian friedrich Hahnemann is the founder of Homoeopathy. He was born in the early hours of 10th April 1755. He was an Allopathic physician having MD Qualification. He left Allopathic practice & adopted translating profession, for his living requirements.

During his life time, he published more than 116 large works & about 120 pamplets on different scientific topics. He founded & accepted chair on Homoeopathy at the leipzic University from 1812 to 1821. He was a great chemist too.

His life was one long victory of accomplishments. He wrote many books on Homoeopathy. His death at the age of eighty nine years at Paris on the morning of Sunday 2nd July 1843 put an end to his earthly life but never to his fame & his glory. He remained all through in the "Hall of fame" Dr. Hahnemann is dead, but his mighty truth cannot die,. "He did not live invain".

About the College

R.B.T.S Govt. Homoeo. Medical college & Hospital Muzaffarpur was established on 26th May 1958 in a sprawling about five & half acres of land. It is situated in the heart land of the city with adequate transportage & other necessary infrastructual facilities. It is situated in the south entry point of the town near Ramdaylu Nagar Station.

The College is the only Govt. Homoeo Medical. College in Bihar. It is affiliated to the B.R.A Bihar university, Muzaffarpur and is recommended and recognised by the central council of Homoeopathy New Delhi and by the Ministry of AYUSH govt. of India respectively. The highly qualified and experienced faculty members impart Homoeopathic education to the students as well as train them practically & clinically to make them able to face the modern challenges of the medical problems. In the total five & half years of graduation course encluding 1 year of compulsory internship training the students are being trained to become a classical Homoeopathic Doctor.

The college has a fulfledged running hospital with O.P.D & I.P.D facilities. We treat approximately more than 60,000 (Sixty Thousand) patients per year in our hospital free of cost.

The house staff (grihpal) and interns are getting regular monthly stipend from the govt. of Bihar as is given in other systems of treatment of 51/2 years duration of the course.

The govt. of India declared this institution a model college and the govt. of Bihar has generously and sincerely made all efforts to provide all necessary infrastructures & facilities to achieve the goal so that the M.D (Homoeo) course may be started in the college at an earliest.

About Admission to the College

Eligibility- The eligibility for admission in the 1st B.H.M.S course is I.Sc (Biology) or its equivalent Qualification.

Procedure of admission- For admission in the lst BHMS course the test exam is conducted by Bihar Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board. (BCECEB) Patna and after the counselling of the successful. candidates the B.C.E.C.E Board. Patna provides admit order to the eligible candidates for admission. There is no provision for direct admission in college.

Important: At the time of Admission:- Affidavit from the father/Guardian & candidate is essential regarding anti-ragging.

About Internship Course

It is of 12 months compulsory, rotatory, internship training course after passing final B.H.M.S examination of 4½ years duration.







About Annual Intake Capacity

The Annual intake allowed seats are 60 only which are to be admitted in an academic year with reservation rules as fixed by govt. of Bihar.

About Fee Structure

A total sum of admission charges for admission into 1st BHMS course is Rs. 522/- (Five hundred twenty two only) excluding the charges for prospectus and university Registration.

About Hostel Facility

Boy's Students can get admission in the hostel which is situated in the college campus (after passing 2nd BHMS, university exam, provided seats are available. The fee is Rs 100/- per month per student.

About College Hours

The College and office hours are from 10 AM to 5PM daily on Bihar Govt. working days.

About Attendance

A minimum of 75% attendance in all subjects is essential for Qualifying to appear in the ensuing university examination.
